FUEL, EMISSIONS AND AIR QUALITY POLICY

Land Recovery Ltd and Land Recovery Rail Ltd recognise that the energy, products and services it uses cause emissions of greenhouse gases (GHGs) to the atmosphere, resulting in climate change both as an employer and as a company. (from herein all references to Land Recovery Ltd also apply to Land Recovery Rail Ltd).

Land Recovery Ltd understands and accepts its responsibilities to monitor fuel consumption and vehicle emissions and will comply with industry and client standards / policies and the requirements within our documented occupational and environmental management system.

Land Recovery Ltd have appointed Stephen Hepple, Logistics Coordinator, as the Fuel and Emissions Champion, with the support of the Accounts Manager.

Land Recovery Ltd are committed to reducing the impact on the air quality and climate change by their vehicles through:

- Ensuring environmental regulations and standards are complied with through monthly legal reviews and ensuring company procedures are kept up to date reflecting any changes in regulations or standards.
- Ensuring all company vehicles have tracking devices fitted which encompasses driver behaviour, routes, speed, MPG and idling.
- Regularly review the data gathered from vehicle tracking systems and use this information to analyse, address any issues and look for areas of improvement such as engine idling or harsh braking patterns.
- Having a fully operational fuel management system in place.
- Monitor fuel usage and AdBlue and investigate any anomalies.
- Organise and plan our fleet efficiently and effectively using safest and best suited route for journeys.
- Operate well maintained vehicles and purchase new to keep up to date with new technologies, transport, and environmental legislation.
- promote its carbon ambition to stakeholders and work with partners to reduce GHG emissions across the value chain.
- manage energy consumption.
- carry out annual surveys to assess our progress against our targets and identify future energy savings and areas for waste minimisation.
- audit all policies to ensure that they are aligned with our net zero strategy.
- Ensure that any fuel spillages are managed effectively to minimise the impact on the environment and controlled in line with LRLEP003 Environmental Spills Emergency Plan.

The Managing Director and Directors fully support this policy and will actively communicate and promote the importance and relevance of it to all our staff.

This policy will be made available to all staff at induction, via the Company One Drive and on company notice boards. The policy is available to view by interested parties via the Land Recovery Ltd upon request.

This policy shall be reviewed as a result of any significant changes or at least annually as part of the Management Review process defined in the Land Recovery Ltd Business Systems Manual.
