TYRE MANAGEMENT POLICY

Land Recovery Ltd and Land Recovery Rail Ltd (from herein all references to Land Recovery Ltd also apply to Land Recovery Rail Ltd). recognises its responsibility to ensure that tyre consumption is managed effectively to reduce the impact of the fleet's operations on the environment.

Land Recovery is committed to ensuring that a high standard of road worthiness and driving etiquette is attained in respect of tyre condition, and to ensure that the maximum life of tyres is achieved in the desire to reduce tyre usage.

This policy applies to all transport and maintenance staff, employed and sub-contractors, as part of the Health & Safety policy, Environment policy and Sustainability policy, and aims to achieve its purpose by considering and continuously improving all aspects of the fleet operation that relate to tyre condition and usage. The company takes all reasonable steps to prevent serious events occurring. Several control measures have been identified and are communicated as part of this policy. The company expects these measures to be adhered to and will take appropriate action against staff who fail to do so. The control measures include:

- Daily walkaround checks
- 6-weekly safety inspections and maintenance
- Ensuring tyres are procured in line with LRLP007
- Ensure tyres are disposed of with least impact on the environment

This policy is supported by procedure LRLP048 Tyre Management.

The Managing Director and Directors fully support this policy and will actively communicate and promote the importance and relevance of it to all our staff.

This policy will be made available to all staff at induction, via the Company One Drive and on company notice boards. The Policy is available to view by interested parties via the Land Recovery Ltd upon request.

This policy shall be reviewed as a result of any significant changes or at least annually as part of the Management Review process defined in the Land Recovery Ltd Business Systems Manual.
